Dear Parents,

The Hockey season will commence on Saturday 29th April 2017 (Saturday at end of Wk 1 Term 2). Please see below for the format of the Tamworth Hockey Competition this year for Junior Girls and Minkey along with registration information and approximate costs.

- **Minkey - U7's and U9's**
U7's will have 6 on the field at once, whilst the U9's will have 7 on the field. Both age groups will play their game over a quarter of the field. This is to allow the players to become more involved in the game.
- **Junior Girls U11's and Division 1**
U11's age group will be made up of girls from years 3&4. This will be played over a half a field with 8 players on the field at once including the goalie. Again, this is to allow the players to have more touches of the ball and become more involved.
The Division 1 competition (yrs 5 & 6 girls) will be played on a full field with 11 players on the field at once including a goalie.
- **Registrations**
On the back of this page will be information that is required for me to be able to register your child. Please make sure that you fill out these details accurately, so that there are no mistakes or hold ups with the registration process.
- **Cost**
We are still waiting on costing from Tamworth Hockey for the 2017 season however, it will be something similar to last year. The 2016 costs have been listed below as a guide only. Please do not send in or pay any money as yet. Once we receive confirmation we will send home another note with full costs.
The cost will depend on the age your child is turning, not necessarily the division they are playing in. Eg. Most girls in Division 2 will come under the \$165 payment scale. Some girls playing Div 1 will also be under this scale.
Minkey – U7's \$55 per player
Minkey – U9's \$70 per player
U11's including Division 1 & 2 - \$165
U18's Division - \$185

Equipment

Each player is required to have their own mouth guard, shin pads and hockey stick. Please also make sure that your child brings a water bottle to each game and that your equipment is labelled with their name and the school's name.

Uniform

All students are required to wear their full sports uniform including the new school sports socks to play hockey in. Junior Girls who are in either Div 1 or U11's are required to also wear the new skort or shorts. Both the socks, skorts or shorts are available at Rose Cottage.

Please read the risk warning and return the permission note, to the Primary office by no later than Tuesday 14th March 2017. As soon as costs are available, another note with more information and team lists will be sent home. Once teams are full, no more registrations will be accepted.
