The Task:

The aim of the task will be to safely select an animal for showing based on its structural characteristics. Safely and effectively break the animal in for leading. Prepare the animal for show day and then enter the animal into the show competition. Whilst exhibiting safe stock handling techniques.

There will be a picture portfolio required to be completed.
You may perform the task in a groups.

Practical task:

1. Select an animal from the farm on its structural and temperament attributes
2. Safely tie the animal up for the first time.
3. Teach the animal to be quiet and unafraid of people's movements.
4. Lead the animal around.
5. Wash and prepare it for showing.
6. Clip the animal to highlight attributes and hide faults.
7. Prepare the animal on show day.
8. Parade the animal in the show.

Picture Portfolio:

You are to present a log book that includes pictures and evidence that you have performed each of the above practical task safely and effectively. Each individual person needs to have their own picture log. This log book can be submitted onto Seesaw as you are performing each task and then printed off at the completion of the activity.
