

How to study for your Preliminary English Extension One Yearly Examination

Your Year 11 English Extension One Yearly Examination is going to consist of one paper, with TWO individual sections.

The first section will ask you to compose a piece of imaginative writing based on your extensive knowledge of the Gothic genre. You should ensure that you read the question carefully, and significantly incorporate the stimulus provided.

For the second section, you will be asked to complete an essay based on your knowledge of the evolution of the Gothic Genre. To complete this response, you will need to draw upon both your understanding of the Gothic genre and your knowledge of the episodes of Buffy the Vampire Slayer viewed in class. **YOU DO NOT NEED A RELATED TEXT FOR THIS SECTION.** You should make reference to at least two episodes.

You will have two hours to complete your paper, (you should plan to spend about one hour on each section) as well as five minutes reading time.

If you ask them VERY nicely, your teachers may be able to provide you with practice questions for each section.

Episodes Viewed in Class Are: Welcome to the Hellmouth/The Harvest, Faith Hope and Trick, Earshot, Hush, The Body, Once More With Feeling.
