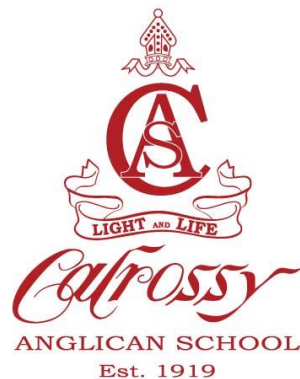

Dear Parents,

Welcome to the 2017 Semester 2 Calrossy Primary School Basketball season. All ongoing and updated information will be on our school website. This is located at <http://joomla.calrossy.nsw.edu.au/> From there, you can follow the Primary Sport link which will lead you to the Basketball icon. On this site you will also be able to access the Tamworth Basketball Association website along with player registration forms and other important information.

The 2017 season commences on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> August however, if teams are finalised early next week trial games will be played on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> July. The permission note on the back section of this note will need to be brought into Reception at the William Cowper Campus by no later than Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> July.

**Primary Competition** –There are 2 Primary Competitions each year that are run on Thursday nights through Terms 1 & 2 and again through Terms 3 & 4. The competition is played across 4 age groups, Years 3&4 Boys, Years 3&4 Girls, Year 5&6 Boys and Years 5&6 Girls. Games are played at the Tamworth Sports Dome on Jack Smyth Drive (near the TREC). **Teams will most likely stay the same as Semester one numbers permitting.**

The cost for the Primary Competition will be \$100 if your child played last Semester however, parents will need to check online at [tamworthbasketball.com.au](http://tamworthbasketball.com.au) to see if your child's registration is due or call Peter McDonald from Tamworth Basketball on 67622986. If registration is due there will be an additional \$80 registration fee which will need to be paid online to Tamworth basketball or at the sports dome. Tamworth Basketball has now also stopped the \$7 door payment. Rather than paying this weekly, parents will now have to pay this upfront which is \$100 for the season (Terms 3 & 4). This will cover all door entries for trials, weekly games and finals.

Could you please:

- 1) Indicate on the back of this note what competition your child will be playing in eg, Year 3 & 4 Boys or Girls Teams or Year 5 & 6 Boys or Girls Teams.
- 2) Could you also please indicate if you are willing to coach or be a manager for one of our teams. We will require assistance in this area and are happy to assist parents with coaching qualifications and resources when required. Without coaches, teams cannot participate. Please note: Tim O'Callaghan will not be coaching the teams he had in the Semester one competition
- 3) Read the Risk Warning on the back of this page and sign and date the permission note.
- 4) Understand that if your child plays Basketball, parents will be required to do the scoring (bench) normally once a term.

RISK WARNING UNDER SECTION 5M OF THE CIVIL LIABILITY ACT OF 2002  
EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Calrossy Anglican School participates in a variety of extra-curricular activities, including excursions both interstate and in the local region. While Calrossy Anglican School takes measures to make the activities as safe as possible for participants, there is a risk that students can be injured and suffer loss (including financial loss) and damage as a result of their participation in these excursions.

Injury can occur while the student is engaging in or watching an extra-curricular activity, or travelling to and from the event. The injury may result from a student's actions or the actions of others. On some occasions, an injury can be serious (such as torn ligaments, dislocations, back injuries, concussion or broken bones). In very rare cases the injury can be life threatening or result in permanent disability. If a student has a pre-existing injury, participating in one of these activities could result in an exacerbation of that injury. Students could also suffer loss as a result of their personal property being lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed.
