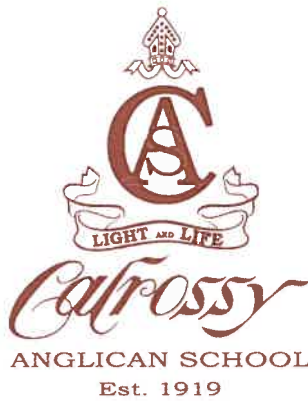

Year 9 students will perform between 5pm and 7pm, and Year 10 students will perform between 7pm and 8:30pm. Year 10 students should be at the Peter Smart Centre by 6.30pm.

Students are to arrive in their theatre blacks, and can change into their costume item prior to their performance.
