Using Adobe Voice on your iPads record yourself speaking in English and German. Back up your spoken information with appropriate images/photos. The content of this task is mostly based on your course book, Feuerwerk 1, Chapters 1-3. For the English Section you will have to draw on topics discussed in class, the Internet or Media.

### **In English (10 Marks):**

Talk about Germany. Speak for approximately 2 Minutes. Explain 10 facts you have learned about Germany or German people. Include photos or images for each point.

For Example: Germany is a small country compared to Australia and lies in the heart of Europe. Surrounding countries are: Austria, Switzerland,....Show a map of Germany with all it's surrounding countries.

Cultural facts may interest you such as festivals or sport (The World Cup) or food. Make it fun and interesting!
