Design	<p><u>Flow chart of Cradle to Grave</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students have produced a detailed flow chart that has displayed a extensive understanding of the food process. It is a clear and consise flow chart with arrows. (10 Marks) • Students have made a thorough attempt at completing the flow chart however it lacked detail and is difficult to read. However it may still include all the relevant information. (8 marks) • Students have attempted to produce a sound flow chart however it lacks detail and is difficult to understand. Some information is missing within the flow chart. (6 marks) • Students have attempted to produce a flow chart however is is difficult to read and only includes the basic information. (4 marks) • Students have made an attempt at completing a flow chart at an elementary level of achievement and shows very little information. (2 marks) 	/10
